

## **Booster Club Minutes**

February 08, 2010

Last month's minutes were accepted.

The Winter Athletes Appreciation Dinner was held Jan 21, 2010. Approximately 210 athletes were fed.

That same night OABC hosted a college athletic recruitment seminar featuring Wayne Mazzoni. 25–30 people attended. This topic will be revisited next year to decide whether or not to have a seminar. Ed recommended co-sponsoring with another organization in order to reduce the cost.

### **Reports-**

**Membership** – 7 coaches are members and we have 2 new members.

**Website**- there have been 2,080 hits on the website since September.

**Treasurer's report** – there haven't been many changes since the last meeting and we have almost \$27,500 in the bank.

**Scoreboard** – There is a meeting next week with Ken Waldron. Some of the school board members are putting on pressure to get this done.

**Senior sports banquet** – a \$500 deposit was given to Colonial Terrace for June 1<sup>st</sup>. The price will remain the same. Should we do a raffle fundraiser again? This will be revisited next month.

**Senior athlete scholarships** – the form was sent out. Should we raise the money allotted for this? Irwin motioned to raise the allotted money to \$3,000. Mary seconded the motion and all were in favor. The scholarship committee will determine how to distribute the \$3,000.

### **New Business –**

**Conditioning clinic** – Luis & Lonnie want to run a conditioning clinic this summer with OABC sponsoring it. This would include OABC paying for Luis' fee and advertising for this event. It would be Monday, Wednesday & Friday from 5:30 – 7:00 and 7:00 – 8:30. Luis wants to limit it to Ossining students and children of Ossining faculty. He also wants to have a session for parents. It would be \$10 per session, or \$30 per week or \$90 for the entire 3 weeks. Pre-registration would be required. The ratio of coaches to kids would be 1:10. OABC requested a budget from Luis before we can proceed with his request. He also needs to look into insurance through Linda Carpenter's office. Luis also needs to come up with a plan in case of inclement weather.

**Elections** – nominations for next year's Board will be in April with the vote being in May. The positions and their descriptions will be posted on the website.

### **Open to Floor –**

There will be a coach's certification seminar this Saturday at the Oss. Rec. Center. Andrew has invited OABC to hand out brochures and speak to the parents. Kay will do this.

OHS may host a track meet in the Spring. It could be April 17<sup>th</sup>. The track coach is looking to OABC for support. OABC needs its role defined before we can give an answer.
